

Meter Installation Timeline & What to Expect

Meter Installation Timeline

Meter sets are typically completed within a few days, but in some cases, it may take up to 30 business days. Our average set time in 2025 is 5 business days.



What Happens Next

- **o Safety First:** Our Metering team will follow all current safety protocols and wear appropriate protective gear to keep everyone safe.
- o Installer Responsibilities: Your installer is responsible for making sure your system meets:
 - The National Electrical Code
 - Local jurisdiction requirements
 - TEP's Service Requirements

If there are any clear issues with these requirements, we won't be able to set the meter until they're resolved.

 Permission to Operate (PTO): Once your meter is set, you'll receive your official Permission to Operate letter by email within 72 hours. This letter gives you the green light to turn on your system.



Access & Safety Reminders

To help us complete your meter set smoothly:

- o Please ensure we have a clear and safe workspace.
- **o** Let us know if you have a **beloved pet in the yard** or a **locked gate** we want to keep everyone safe and avoid delays.
- o If access is restricted, we may need to **schedule your meter set** in advance.



Important Notes

- o Thanks to our AMI Meter Exchange project, which upgraded all meters in our service area with the latest technology, meter installations are now quick and seamless. In most cases, there's no need to worry about a power outage during the process. Our team can complete the work without needing to contact you — unless there's an access issue at your property.
- After you receive your PTO letter, your **installer will help you power on your system**. For safety reasons, TEP personnel do not energize customer owned systems.
