4	Committee, commencing at 11:00 a.m. on June 6, 2025, with
5	all participants appearing via videoconference.

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- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: Let's go on the record. Now
- 2 is the time set for the prehearing conference in the
- 3 application of TEP for its Marana reliability project,
- 4 Docket Number L-00000C-25-0094-00246, or Line Siting Case
- 5 246.
- 6 Let's start with taking appearances.
- 7 Ms. Grabel.
- 8 MS GRABEL: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Meghan
- 9 Grabel of Osborn Maledon on behalf of Tucson Electric
- 10 Power Company. With me from my firm is Elias Ancharski.
- 11 With me from Tucson Electric Power Company are Mr. Clark
- 12 Bryner and Adriana Marinez. And with us from SWCA is
- 13 Theresa Knoblock.
- 14 Nailed it this time.
- 15 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. And just
- 16 confirming that you have the lodging arrangements for the
- 17 committee members for the hearing?
- 18 MS GRABEL: Yes, that's true. We are
- 19 putting the hearing members up at the Comfort Inn and
- 20 Suites located on Cracker Barrel Road in Marana.
- 21 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. I seem to recall
- 22 that some of the members hadn't booked rooms. Do you know
- 23 how many members have booked rooms?
- 24 MS GRABEL: I don't recall how many have or
- 25 have not. I know the cutoff date was May 30th.

- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. We think you
- 2 have a few that actually reside in Tucson, so they will --
- 3 they won't -- they won't need lodging.
- 4 MS GRABEL: Yeah.
- 5 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. And you have --
- 6 Let's see. You have six prehearing exhibits; correct?
- 7 MS GRABEL: Correct.
- 8 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Number 1 is the map
- 9 of the project.
- 10 2 is the notice of service to affected
- 11 jurisdictions.
- 12 3 is an example of the sign contents.
- 4 is the map showing the locations of the
- 14 posted signs.
- 15 5 is the tour itinerary and script.
- 16 And 6 is the proposed certificate of
- 17 environmental compatibility.
- 18 Those are going to be admitted.
- 19 MS GRABEL: Thank you.
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. There haven't been
- 21 any requests to intervene that I have seen. Is that --
- 22 MS GRABEL: We are aware of none, correct.
- 23 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And let's see. There
- 24 have been no limited appearance statements filed?
- MS GRABEL: Correct.

- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Now, let's see. The
- 2 applicant agrees that October 29th, 2025, is the time
- 3 limit for the Committee to act under the statute; correct?
- 4 MS GRABEL: Yes, that's correct.
- 5 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay, let's see. The
- 6 affected jurisdictions are the City of Marana, the
- 7 counties of Pima and Pinal. And then the State agencies:
- 8 State land department and Arizona Department of
- 9 Transportation; correct?
- 10 MS GRABEL: Yes, except Marana is a town,
- 11 not a city. I don't know that it matters.
- 12 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. All right. And then
- 13 let's see. One of the exhibits is the -- Let's see. 2 is
- 14 the notice of service to the affected jurisdictions. It
- 15 looks like you had to end up serving Marana and Pinal
- 16 County with a process server.
- 17 MS GRABEL: Right. We didn't get the
- 18 certified mail back. This has happened to us before. And
- 19 we just wanted to be able to demonstrate that we actually
- 20 did give it to them, even though the statute requires us
- 21 to do it by certified mail. So we did do it the right way
- 22 first, but we couldn't get it to them, so we decided let's
- 23 process-serve them.
- 24 CHMN STAFFORD: Excellent. Well, they have
- 25 actual notice. I think you're -- I think serving them

- 1 with the process server is --
- 2 MS GRABEL: Above and beyond.
- 3 CHMN STAFFORD: -- certified mail, so I
- 4 think you have more than complied with the notice
- 5 requirements.
- 6 And the publishing requirements, you had
- 7 those in there as well. Looks like you published twice in
- 8 the Arizona Daily Star, March 7th and 11th, which is more
- 9 than 30 days before the hearing. You also published in a
- 10 couple other newspapers in an abundance of caution.
- 11 MS GRABEL: It was more just because we
- 12 thought those were the readership of the area. So it was
- 13 the Explorer and Marana News. That was on May 7th. And
- 14 we published in the Arizona Bilingual on May 26th.
- 15 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. All right. And you
- 16 have seen the agenda. Are there any objections or
- 17 additions to that?
- 18 MS GRABEL: No, sir.
- 19 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. The hearing is going
- 20 to be at the -- from June 16th through the 20th. I don't
- 21 anticipate it will take that long -- and it will be at
- 22 the --
- What's the location again?
- 24 MS GRABEL: It's the Northwest Fire District
- 25 Training Center.

- 1 And I'm going to send you a map,
- 2 Mr. Chairman, because it's an interesting place to get
- 3 into and there are some restrictions as to where people
- 4 can smoke and not smoke. So I'll send you that so the
- 5 Committee members can kind of figure out the lay of the
- 6 land before they get there.
- 7 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Just send it to Tod
- 8 and he will distribute it to the members then and that
- 9 will work.
- 10 MS GRABEL: Will do.
- 11 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Let's see. Looks
- 12 like you have three witnesses. I am assuming you
- 13 anticipate being done with the hearing by Tuesday
- 14 afternoon. Correct?
- 15 MS GRABEL: That would be awesome. Our
- 16 internal bet is Wednesday.
- 17 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay.
- 18 MS GRABEL: But it also depends on the
- 19 length of the tour. We would propose a tour on Monday
- 20 morning and then followed by a lunch.
- 21 CHMN STAFFORD: You mean Tuesday morning?
- 22 MS GRABEL: Tuesday morning. That's what I
- 23 mean, yes.
- 24 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Okay. And you
- 25 have -- I assume you have Peaks Audio for the AV setup.

- 1 All right. And you'll have signed forms for
- 2 public comment. Do you anticipate much public comment?
- MS GRABEL: You know, we've had really good
- 4 outreach and there's been a lot of really positive
- 5 comments, so I don't know.
- Adriana, I kind defer to you. Do you
- 7 anticipate much public comment?
- 8 MS. MARINEZ: I don't.
- 9 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Will there be any
- 10 need for security at the hearing?
- 11 MS GRABEL: No, there will not.
- 12 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. You've got the tour
- 13 plan and the script. I like to -- on these multiple route
- 14 cases when you have the ability to say, okay, as you drive
- 15 past the checkpoint there is a script that can describe
- 16 what you are looking at instead of having to wait for the
- 17 next stop and get the court reporter out. I think that
- 18 works out pretty well.
- 19 MS GRABEL: Good.
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And we'll have the
- 21 daily transcripts, the Wi-Fi. Business casual for the
- 22 hearing attire.
- 23 THE COURT REPORTER: Did you say daily
- 24 transcripts?
- 25 CHMN STAFFORD: No, we're not doing daily

- 1 transcripts. I'm just looking at the checklist and it
- 2 says if daily transcripts, breaks every 90 minutes. We
- 3 don't need daily since it's three days after the
- 4 conclusion. We do break every 90 minutes, though. Yeah.
- 5 All right. And you've got -- You don't have
- 6 any segments where you have groups opposed to certain
- 7 segments for this case, do you?
- 8 MS GRABEL: Will you repeat that,
- 9 Mr. Chairman?
- 10 CHMN STAFFORD: You don't have like a group
- 11 of -- you don't have -- Because you have multiple routes
- 12 you don't have different groups of people that are opposed
- 13 to different segments of the route then; correct?
- 14 MS GRABEL: That's correct. We have some
- 15 routes that are probably more popular with the residential
- 16 residences in the area than others, but no one is opposed
- 17 to any of the routes.
- 18 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And you have got
- 19 your -- filed your witness summaries. And I've received
- 20 the hard copy of the exhibits for the hearing already.
- 21 MS GRABEL: Yes. Those were delivered to
- 22 you yesterday.
- 23 CHMN STAFFORD: Yep.
- 24 So we've got -- I guess there was no other
- 25 parties to exchange exhibits with.

- 1 MS GRABEL: Correct.
- 2 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. And
- 3 you've made the financial arrangements with the
- 4 Commission?
- 5 MS GRABEL: We have.
- 6 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Now, staff has not
- 7 responded to my letter of requesting their comment. I
- 8 anticipate they will file that probably next week.
- 9 MS GRABEL: I would agree. We did get data
- 10 requests from staff and we have responded to those, so we
- 11 anticipate that a letter is forthcoming.
- 12 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And I assume you'll
- 13 introduce that as a new exhibit at the hearing, Number 16.
- MS GRABEL: Yes.
- 15 CHMN STAFFORD: There is no related
- 16 litigation.
- 17 Okay. We've got the draft CEC. No one is
- 18 objecting to that because there is no other parties.
- 19 Let's see.
- 20 Did you meet with SHPO at all in
- 21 consultation on this?
- 22 MS GRABEL: We absolutely did. We met with
- 23 SHPO and the other affected utilities and we negotiated
- 24 language that was acceptable to everybody. So we don't
- 25 anticipate any objection on the language.

- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And then do you have
- 2 any -- I haven't looked through all the exhibits yet. Do
- 3 you have any -- And I didn't see it in the application.
- 4 Do you have any correspondence from SHPO on their position
- 5 on any of the routes?
- 6 MS GRABEL: Ms. Marinez, would you answer
- 7 that question?
- 8 MS. MARINEZ: I don't believe we have any
- 9 formal comments from them on any routes.
- 10 MS GRABEL: We do have communications from
- 11 SHPO with respect to the conditions and we have comments
- 12 from them with respect to the type of environmental survey
- 13 that will be required. But I am not sure that they
- 14 actually opined on any of the routes themselves.
- 15 Is that right, Adriana?
- 16 MS. MARINEZ: Yes. I would agree with that,
- 17 yes. Thank you.
- 18 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. But they didn't opine
- 19 on what be would necessary for any of the routes then.
- 20 Because I seem to recall from the application there's a
- 21 number of historical sites listed in the area of -- not
- 22 the area affected, it's the study area I guess. Correct?
- MS GRABEL: That's correct, yes.
- 24 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And so what's the
- 25 status of any other permits from either the federal,

- 1 State, County or City or Town?
- 2 MS GRABEL: We're going to need a
- 3 conditional use permit for the switchyard, the Owl Head
- 4 Ranch switchyard. We need some right-of-way permits from
- 5 ADOT, from Union Pacific Railroad, Kinder Morgan, and
- 6 potentially others. And then we do have -- we cross the
- 7 Central Arizona Project canal, so that might require a
- 8 NEPA process. But that's likely going to be an EA, not an
- 9 extensive analysis.
- 10 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And that has -- none
- 11 of that's -- The NEPA process hasn't begun yet?
- 12 MS GRABEL: I don't believe so.
- 13 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay.
- MS. MARINEZ: It hasn't.
- 15 CHMN STAFFORD: Pardon?
- MS. MARINEZ: It hasn't.
- 17 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And what about the
- 18 conditional use permit for the switchyard; has that
- 19 already commenced?
- MS GRABEL: No, it has not.
- 21 MS. MARINEZ: Not for the switchyard, no.
- 22 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And then I'm assuming
- 23 that the transmission line itself is a permitted use.
- MS GRABEL: I believe that's true, yes.
- 25 Correct.

- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Okay. Let me just
- 2 make sure I got that. I don't write as fast as you talk.
- 3 So you have got -- there's going to be a
- 4 permit for the cross from ADOT and from which railroad?
- 5 MS GRABEL: Union Pacific.
- 6 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And they have --
- 7 Where are -- do those stand in the process?
- I quess you probably wait to get a route and
- 9 then you'll talk to them about where you are going to need
- 10 to cross. Correct?
- 11 MS GRABEL: That is correct.
- 12 And that's also true with Kinder Morgan.
- 13 There's a pipeline in the area that might encroach. We'll
- 14 need a permit from them as well.
- 15 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. All right. Now, for
- 16 the hearing you'll have the exhibits for hearing
- 17 members -- for the committee members at the hearing on
- 18 tablets I assume. Correct?
- 19 MS GRABEL: That's correct.
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: And you'll have -- I already
- 21 have my hard copy, so you will only need one more hard
- 22 copy for the court reporter.
- MS GRABEL: That's good.
- 24 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Are there any
- 25 other issues that we need to cover?

1	MS GRABEL: I don't believe so, no.
2	CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Do you have
3	everything you need, Jill?
4	THE COURT REPORTER: SHPO.
5	CHMN STAFFORD: All right.
6	THE COURT REPORTER: I need the spelling for
7	SHPO.
8	CHMN STAFFORD: Oh, it's it's an acronym.
9	S-H-P-O. It stands for the State Historic Preservation
10	Office.
11	THE COURT REPORTER: Thank you.
12	CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Do we have
13	everything we need, Tod?
14	MR. BREWER: Yes, Mr. Chairman. Thank you.
15	CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Thank you all
16	very much. We are adjourned and I will see you on the
17	16th.
18	MS GRABEL: Bye.
19	MR. BRYNER: Thank you. See you.
