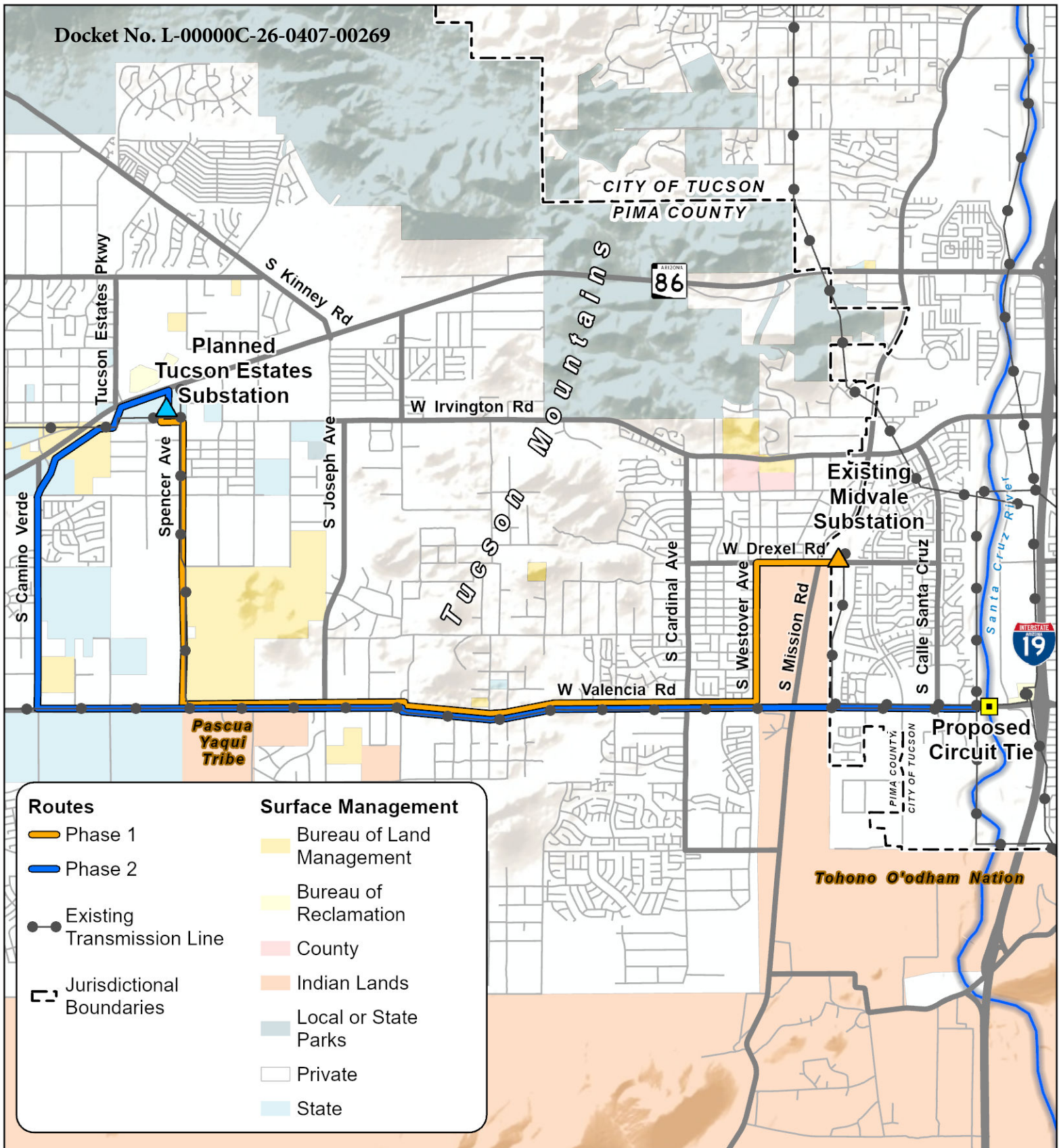
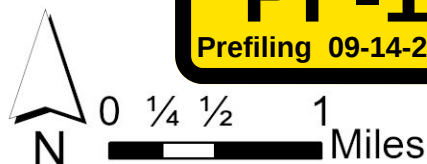




Southwest Tucson Reliability Project Route Map

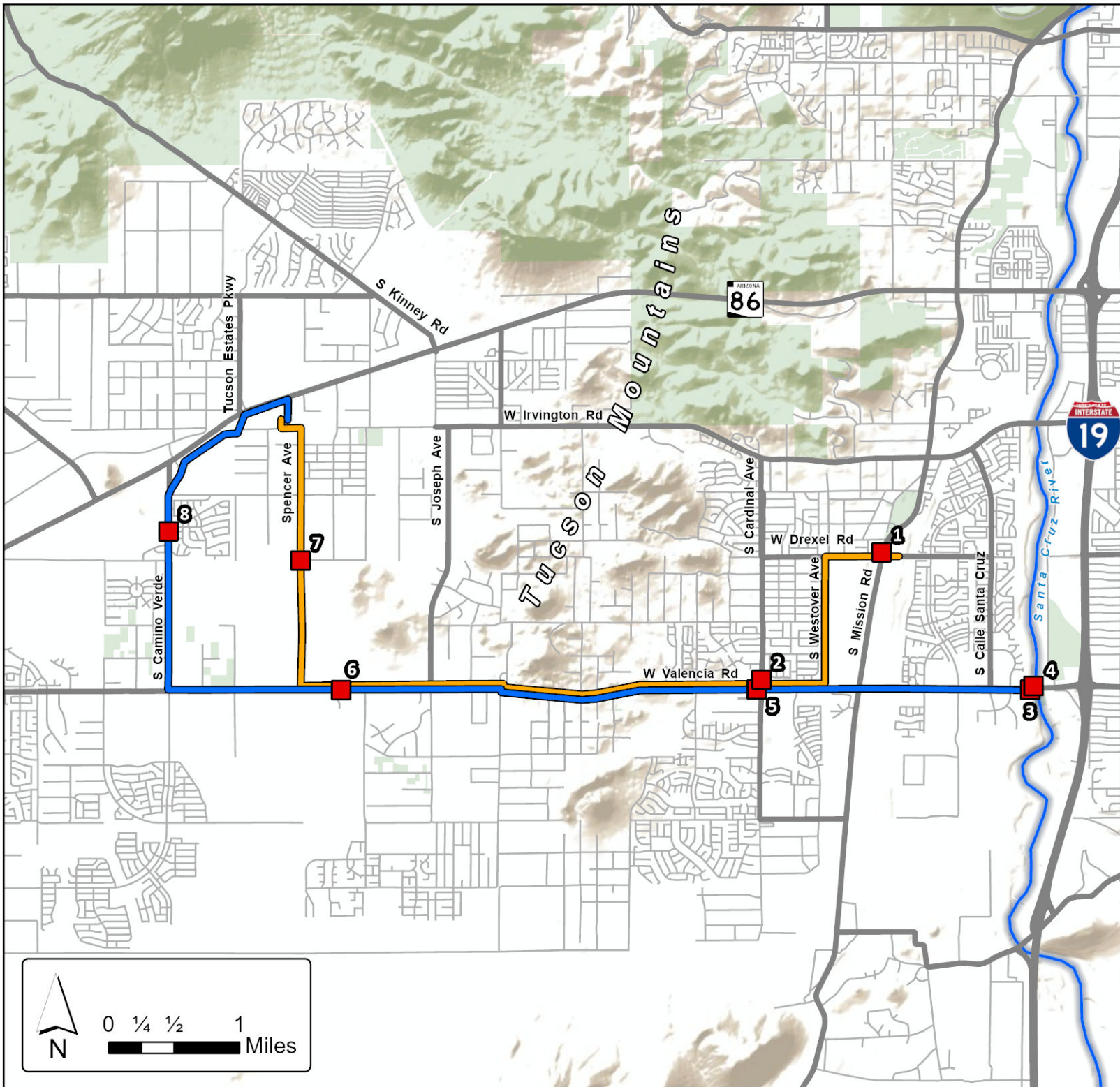

NOTICE OF HEARING



NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the Application of Tucson Electric Power Company (“TEP” or “Applicant”) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (“CEC”) to authorize construction of a new 138 kilovolt (“kV”) transmission line in the City of Tucson and unincorporated Pima County, Arizona, called the Southwest Tucson Reliability Project (“Project”).

The Project will include an approximately 17-mile looped transmission line consisting of two new 138-kV circuits. The Project will be completed in two phases. Phase 1 of the Project will connect TEP’s existing Midvale Substation in the City of Tucson to TEP’s planned Tucson Estates Substation in unincorporated Pima County. Phase 2 of the Project will connect TEP’s planned Tucson Estates Substation in unincorporated Pima County to a tie-in point on TEP’s existing Midvale-South 138-kV transmission line in the City of Tucson. A map of the Project is attached as **Exhibit A**.

The hearing will be held at the Arizona Corporation Commission’s Tucson Offices, 400 W. Congress Street, Tucson, Arizona 85701. **The hearing will begin on Wednesday, November 4, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., and will continue on Thursday,**

1 November 5, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., and then will continue as necessary through Friday,
2 November 6, 2026, beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day through the completion of the

17 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and telephone
18 hearing access, as well as any additional details regarding safety protocols or other
19 revisions to the hearing schedule will be noticed on the Project webpage at

21 The Chairman may, at his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be
22 announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. The date, time, and
23 place at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project
24 webpage and the Commission website. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY RESUMED**
25 **HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A**
26 **RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.**

27 If the Committee decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary
28 of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project and Commission

1 websites. Members of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour,
2 the Committee may hear testimony at stops on the tour concerning what is visible at stops
3 and the relevance of the location and view to the Project. No other discussion or
4 deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A court reporter or
5 recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription. Public
6 health and safety protocols specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary. If the
7 Committee decides not to take a tour, the hearing will continue as scheduled.

15 The Applicant will make available final copies of the prefilings conference,
16 prehearing conference, and hearing transcripts at each of the above locations and webpage.

17 Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project that
18 desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date
19 set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities,
20 Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007.

21 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to
22 promote conservation or natural beauty; to protect the environment, personal health or
23 other biological values; to preserve historical sites; to promote consumer interests; to
24 represent commercial and industrial groups; or to promote the orderly development of the
25 area in which the Project are located that desires to become a party to the proceedings
26 shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent
27 to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200
28 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007.

The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of the Utilities Division, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007, and the Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85004, not less than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S.”) §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-7-101 to R14-7-120. No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the Commission pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceeding on the matter before the Commission must be a party to the proceeding before the Committee.
