Re. Elimination of Super Off-Peak Time-of-Use Electric Vehicle pricing plan

Dear Customer,

Tucson Electric Power customers currently signed up for our <u>Residential Super Off-Peak Time-of-Use Electric Vehicle</u> pricing plan (TRSOTE) will be required to sign up for a new pricing plan by February 29, 2024.

The Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) ordered the elimination of this pricing plan in decision number 79065. Beginning September 1, 2023, residential customers signed up for this pricing plan have six months to choose a new plan. Customers who do not choose a new pricing plan will be moved to our Residential Service Time-of-Use (TRREST) plan.

TEP's Time-of-Use, <u>Demand Time-of-Use</u> and <u>Special Residential Service Time-of-Use</u> plans offer lower rates to residential customers who shift their usage away from on-peak hours and higher rates during periods when customers typically use the most power.

TEP also offers a Residential Demand Super Off-Peak Time-of-Use Electric Vehicle pricing plan, which offers even lower rates for energy use from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. daily to residential customers who own a qualified highway-approved battery electric vehicle or plug-in hybrid electric vehicle and appropriate home charging equipment.
